### Payment Options

Upon enrollment, families pay a non-refundable deposit of \$2,000. The balance of tuition may be paid in one installment, on August 1, two installments due August 1 and December 1, or through an eight-month payment plan, which begins May 1.

### Financial Aid

The Elisabeth Morrow School is committed to providing our families with flexible payment options and financial aid awards to ensure that qualified students are able to receive an Elisabeth Morrow School experience. Admission to the school and financial aid decisions are made independently from one another and awards are based solely on the family's financial resources. The family's income, savings, investments, number of dependents, age of parents and number of children attending tuition-charging schools and colleges are some of the factors used to determine financial aid. The Elisabeth Morrow School awarded over \$500,000 in aid for the 2008-2009 academic year. We continue to work hard to increase our budget, which is reviewed on an annual basis.

The Financial Aid Committee strongly suggests that all required components of the financial aid package be received in the office no later than March 2, 2009.

A complete Financial Aid Packet includes:

- Questionnaire
- The SSS Report
- Copy of 2008 Income Tax Return with all schedules

In order for your file to be complete by March 2, 2009, you must allow at least four weeks for the School and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS) to process your Parent Financial Statement (PFS). Additionally, the Financial Aid Committee strongly encourages families to file their taxes prior to March 2.
