

Chilton House Dress Code

We expect all students to dress neatly and conservatively and to be well groomed. Jeans may not be worn in the classroom. Children's hair should be neat. Clothing should be loose enough to enable full and comfortable participation in all activities. **Clothes with writing and characters are prohibited in school, particularly superhero and/or movie-themed items.** If, in our opinion, a student is inappropriately attired, we will notify the parents. All clothing and footwear, whether worn for class or kept at school, should be clearly marked with your child's name. The school cannot be responsible for lost clothing. The dress code differs in each building.

Please dress your children in comfortable clothing appropriate for activities held on the floor, in the paint area and on the playground. They should **wear sensible, flat, rubber-soled shoes or sneakers.** No open-toe or backless sandals.

We ask that the following items, labeled with your child's name, be kept at school:

- 1 Complete change of clothing with extra pair of underwear and socks
- **In winter:** one pair of boots, one pair of snow pants, one pair of mittens (no gloves)
- 1 pair of sneakers
