

MORROWHOUSE DRESS CODE

The Morrow House Dress Code aims to set a framework of respect for the serious work of the school day, keeping in mind that our school celebrates childhood and individuality. The code establishes a basic set of dress expectations for students. Each morning in advisory, advisors will conduct a general dress code check, ensuring that any violations can be rectified quickly so that the rest of the day can be focused on the business of school. Faculty members and administrators will be the final arbiter of any and all questions about the dress code.

The Dress Code will be in effect for the start of the school year on September 4. I know last year the student council had a proposal approved for “Casual Monday,” which expired at the close of the school year. I look forward to working with students and faculty to brainstorm occasional dress down days in the future. In the meantime, our usual Dress Code will be in effect.

GENERAL DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

- Clothes are to be neat and clean with no rips or patches and should fit properly.
- Excessively revealing clothes are not permitted. Undergarments must be covered.
- No gap at midriff is ever permitted, even with arms raised.
- Outerwear including fleece and down coats and vests may not be worn indoors during the school day.
- Athletic clothing, such as wind pants, sweatpants, mesh, fleece jackets, or athletic shorts, is not permitted.
- Blue denim bottoms or blue jeans are not permitted.
- Spandex-type stretch pants or tights are not permitted.
- Large, distracting writing or logos (except for the EMS logo) are not permitted.
- Hats may not be worn in school buildings during the school day.
- All shirts and blouses must have sleeves (no tank tops or spaghetti straps).
